

## Journals/Portfolios 3-7

Due : December 22<sup>nd</sup> (this is approx. 2 weeks per choice)

For these next **five** journal entries/portfolio selections, you will play BINGO. What that means is that you will make a straight line (either across, down or diagonal) and complete the **five** choices that fall on that line. You cannot pick any **five**, they **MUST be in a line**.

These options are very open ended and meant to give you full creative control. If I do not specify what format I want your project in (ex. slideshow, poem, book, etc...) you can use whatever you would like. For example, if you want to write the biography of an historical person, you can use a slideshow, you can write it as an essay, you can create a glog, webpage or a PhotoStory. I did not specify so it is up to you!

While this may seem like a lot of work, it is possible to finish in the time given. The choices are only as complicated as you make them. If you follow the KISS principle (**Keep It Simple Silly**) you should have no problems.

I will be periodically checking to see how far along you are on each choice. You cannot leave this until the last day to submit; if you do, you will go into work be overloaded. If you want to bring in each choice after it is finished, simply put it in your portfolio and let me know so I can check it off.

As usual, I will be around every day after school if you need time to work on any of it. I may from time to time allow you to work during class. If I decide to do this, I will let you know in advance.
