

## Les adjectifs:

- describes a noun
- agrees in **gender** and **number**

## General Rules for Agreement:

	<b>Singulier</b>	<b>Pluriel</b>
<b>MASCULIN</b>	-	s
<b>FÉMININ</b>	e	es

Since this is French, of course there are exceptions!

1. If the adjective in the masculine form ends in an "e", you do not add another one (unless it is an é!)
2. If the adjective in the masculine singular form ends in an "s" or "x", you do not add another "s" or "x" in the plural form

But wait, there's more....

Masculine Ending	Feminine Ending	Example
vowel + l	vowel + lle	sensationel = <b>fantastic</b> sensationnelle
vowel + n	vowel + nne	bon = bonne <b>good</b>
er or some et	ère or ète	fier = fière <b>proud</b> inquiet = inquiète <b>worried</b>
c	che	blanc = blanche <b>white</b>
f	ve	sportif = sportive <b>athletic</b>
eur	euse or rice	chanteur = <b>singer</b> chanteuse acteur = actrice
eux	euse	heureux = <b>happy</b> heureuse
et	ette	net = nette <b>clean</b>
