```
Subject pronouns:

Je - I

Tu - you (sing.)

II - He

Elle - She

On - we (informal, familiar)

Nous - we (formal)

Vous - you (plural or polite)

Ils - They (group that has at least 1 guy)

Elles - They (group of all girls)
```

How to conjugate verbs:

The infinitive of the verb is the verb in the -er, - ir, or -re form (ex. parler, choisir, prendre)

To conjugate the verbs, you need to drop the verb ending (-er, -ir, or -re). When you drop the ending of the verb, you are left with the "STEM" of the verb. You add the endings that match the subject of the sentence to the stem of the verb.

We will see examples of this in a couple pages.

For REGULAR -ER verbs the endings are:

Je - e

Tu - es

II - e

Elle - e

On - e

Nous - ons

Vous - ez

Ils - ent

Example: PARLER (to talk, to speak)

Infinitive = PARLER
Stem = PARL (the infinitive without the -er)

Je parle (I speak, I am speaking)

Tu parles (You speak, you are speaking)

Il parle (He speaks, he is speaking)

Elle parle (She speaks, she is speaking)

On parle (We talk, we are talking)

Nous parlons (We talk, we are talking)

Vous parlez (You talk, you are talking)

Ils parlent (They speak, they are speaking)

Elles parlent (They speak, they are speaking)

For REGULAR -IR verbs, the endings are:

Je - is
Tu - is
II - it
Elle - it
On - it
Nous - issons
Vous - issez
Ils - issent

Elles - issent

Example: CHOISIR (to choose)

Infinitive = CHOISIR Stem = CHOIS (the infinitive without the -ir)

Je choisis (I choose, I am choosing)
Tu choisis (You choose, you are choosing)
Il choisit (He chooses, he is choosing)
Elle choisit (She chooses, she is choosing)
On choisit (We choose, we are choosing)
Nous choisissons (We choose, we are choosing)
Vous choisissez (You choose, you are choosing)
Ils choisissent (They choose, they are choosing)
Elles choisissent (They choose, they are choosing)

For REGULAR - RE verbs, the endings are:

```
Je - s
Tu - s
II - _
Elle - _
On - _
Nous - ons
Vous - ez
Ils - ent
Elles - ent
```

Example: RÉPONDRE (to answer, to respond)

```
Infinitive = RÉPONDRE
Stem = RÉPOND (the infinitive without the -re)
```

```
Je réponds (I answer, I am answering)
Tu réponds (You answer, you are answering)
Il répond_ (He answers, he is answering)
Elle répond_ (She answers, she is answering)
On répond_ (We answer, we are answering)
Nous répondons (We answer, we are answering)
Vous répondez (You answer, you are answering)
Ils répondent (They answer, they are answering)
Elles répondent (They answer, they are answering)
```

# PRACTICE!

Unfortunately, the most common verbs in French are IRREGULAR. That means that their conjugations do not follow the regular rule of adding the proper endings to the stem.

#### These verb conjugations need to be memorized.

The verbs are: avoir, être, aller, faire, savoir, devoir, pouvoir, vouloir

#### AVOIR - to have

#### POUVOIR - to be able to, can

### DEVOIR - to have to, must
